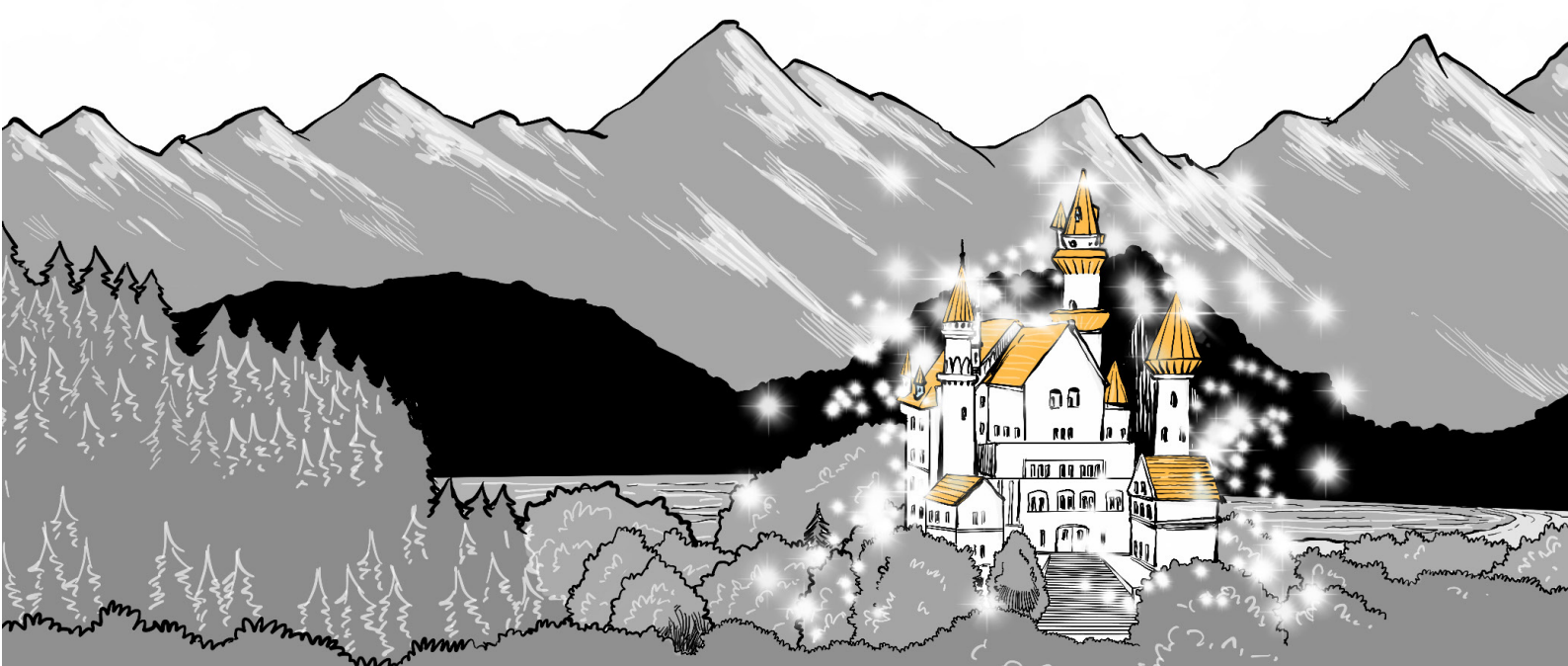


Hidden Messages
